Primary Care Expansion Clinic Types

Collaborative Family Practice Teams

- A team of at least three healthcare providers in one clinic, working together to provide the most relevant, complete and efficient care for every patient.
- There are currently 95 teams
 - Central Zone: 28
 - Eastern Zone: 26
 - Northern Zone: 16
 - Western Zone: 25
- 26 teams to be strengthened through increased staffing, plus renovations at some clinics
- 8 new teams to be established

Central Zone will also be adding a Locum Team which will not be based in a clinic but will provide coverage for primary care practices in the area where needed.

After Hours Clinics

- Provide non-emergency care during weekday evenings and on weekends. Patients must book appointments by calling the clinic. No walk-in patients are accepted.
- There are currently 3 After Hours Clinics
- 1 to be strengthened through increased funding
- 2 new clinics to be established

NOVA

Urgent Treatment Centres

- Provide access to care for those with unexpected, non-life-threatening health concerns. Open weekdays. Some are also open evenings and weekends
- There are currently 7 Urgent Treatment Centres
- 1 new centre to be established

Primary Care Clinics

- Provide short-term primary medical care for people on the Need a Family Practice Registry. Appointments may be provided in-person or virtually depending on the patient's needs and resources available at each clinic. Patients must book appointments.
- There are currently 15 Primary Care Clinics
- 10 clinics to be strengthened through increased funding
- 6 new clinics to be established

Urgent Care Centres

- Provide access to urgent care for attached (and some unattached) patients by forming a group of local primary care practices. These private practices work collectively to provide appointments for each other's patients during evenings and weekends.
- There is currently 1 Urgent Care Centre
- 5 more to be established
