Registration of Undertaking for Environmental Assessment ENVIRONMENT ACT

This is to advise that on December 19, 2014, Mi'kmaq Wind4All Communities L.P. registered the Amherst Community Wind Farm for environmental assessment, in accordance with Part IV of the Environment Act.

The purpose of the proposed undertaking is to develop the Amherst Community Wind Farm located in the Municipality of Cumberland County, Nova Scotia. The project is located east of Amherst and will consist of three Enercon E92 wind turbines with a total rated capacity of 6.0 megawatts.

Project activities are scheduled as follows:

- Pre-construction activities: Winter 2015
- Construction activities: Spring/Summer 2015
- Commissioning: Fall 2015
