Registration of Undertaking for Environmental Assessment ENVIRONMENT ACT

This is to advise that on February 21, 2023, Bear Head Energy Inc. registered a Green Hydrogen and Ammonia Production, Storage and Loading Facility Project for environmental assessment, in accordance with Part IV of the *Environment Act*.

The purpose of the proposed undertaking is to construct and operate a green hydrogen and ammonia facility at the site of the previously approved Bear Head LNG Project in the Point Tupper Industrial Park on the Strait of Canso. At peak operations, the facility will be capable of producing 2 million tonnes per annum of anhydrous ammonia which will be shipped to world markets via approximately 40 to 60 speciality marine carriers per year. Pending the necessary approvals to proceed, Project construction is scheduled to begin in 2024 with plant commissioning and first ammonia production scheduled in late 2027.
