

# NOTICE

## Registration of Undertaking for Environmental Assessment

This is to advise that on May 10, 2004, Access Northeast Energy Inc. registered the proposed Bear Head Liquefied Natural Gas (LNG) Terminal for environmental assessment, in accordance with Part IV of the Nova Scotia *Environment Act*. The proposed project also requires an environmental assessment in accordance with the *Canadian Environmental Assessment Act*. A 90 day harmonized federal/provincial environmental assessment process is currently underway. Copies of all comments submitted will be forwarded to the Canadian Environmental Assessment Agency, Atlantic Region.

The purpose of the proposed undertaking is to construct and operate an LNG terminal and associated facilities in Bear Head near Port Hawkesbury, Nova Scotia. It is anticipated that construction will commence, pending regulatory approvals, in January 2005. Construction will last for approximately two and a half years. Start up and operation of the facility is scheduled for the fall of 2007.
