Registration of Undertaking for Environmental Assessment ENVIRONMENT ACT

This is to advise that on August 25, 2003, Lawson Bennett Trucking Ltd. registered the Cambridge Aggregate Pit Expansion for environmental assessment, in accordance with Part IV of the Environment Act.

The purpose of the proposed Undertaking is to expand the existing Cambridge Pit footprint (located on the south side of Highway # 1, near the Perry Rand bus depot, Cambridge, Kings County, NS) to allow for continued aggregate production, and stockpiling. The proposed Undertaking (proposed to begin in September 2003) will allow the pit to continue operating for ten years.
