Following a review of the information provided by Dexter Construction Company Limited, and the information provided by the Mi'kmaq of Nova Scotia, and the public during consultation on the environmental assessment, I am satisfied that any adverse effects or significant environmental effects of the undertaking can be adequately mitigated through compliance with the attached terms and conditions and through subsequent approvals.

Please be advised that prior to the alteration of any of the wetlands in the Study Area you will be required to apply for and receive the required Wetland Alteration Approval(s) from the Department. Decisions regarding such approvals will be made based on the information provided at the time of application while applying the *Environment Act*, relevant regulations and the Wetland Conservation Policy (attached). In your Environmental Assessment Registration Document, you identified the presence of several species at risk in the Study Area.
