Registration of Addendum to Environmental Assessment

This is to advise that on July 3, 2009, a partnership between SkyPower Corp. and Scotian Windfields Inc. registered the Digby Wind Power Project's Addendum to Environmental Assessment, in accordance with Part IV of the *Environment Act*.

The purpose of the proposed undertaking is to construct and operate a 30 megawatt (MW) wind energy facility consisting of 20, 1.5 MW wind turbine generators with a transmission line (approximately 10.6 km long) to connect to the existing NSPI electrical grid. This facility is proposed to be located in Gulliver's Cove, Digby County, Nova Scotia. The Proponent anticipates start of construction by September 2009, pending permits and approvals, with the facility becoming operational in the Spring of 2010. The estimated lifespan of the facility is anticipated to be approximately 20 years.

The additional information presented for the Digby Wind Power Project addresses concerns around landscape connectivity and noise. The report also provides additional information to demonstrate how public concerns have been considered in the development and operation of the undertaking.
