On February 18, 2026, Renewable Energy Systems (RES) registered the **Eigg Mountain Wind Project** for environmental assessment. The Highfield/Eigg Mountain area, a pristine wilderness situated on an elevated plane, was populated and farmed by Scottish pioneers. In recent years, the area supported forestry and recreation activity such as hiking, cross country skiing and use by snowmobilers and users of all terrain vehicles. This activity will continue.

The **Eigg Mountain Wind Project** is contained within one of the best wind belts in the province. In terms of wind development, it harbours many in-demand, undeveloped land assets with the potential of making a significant contribution to clean energy, reducing carbon emissions as well as energizing 55,000 homes yearly.

RES, the developer, has shown to be a responsible Corporate citizen. It is the world's largest renewable energy company with over 20 years experience developing Canadian wind projects. We are writing to voice our strong support for the Eigg Mountain Wind Project proposed by Renewable Energy Systems (RES). We are currently building an oceanside cottage here in Doctors Brook, and we are deeply invested in the long-term future of Antigonish County. While we understand that some of our neighbors have reservations, we believe the net benefits of this project are simply too significant to pass up.

## Final Submission – Environmental Assessment Review Eigg Mountain Wind Project

To whom it may concern,

As the public comment period closes, I am submitting this final statement to clearly express my position.

Based on the information provided in the Environmental Assessment, as well as the growing concerns raised by community members, I respectfully request that the Eigg Mountain Wind Project be denied approval.

This request is grounded in the following key concerns:

- The project will intertwine with the Eigg Mountain–James River Wilderness Area, with access roads, widened rights-of-way, and transmission infrastructure extending through and impacting the surrounding wilderness landscape.
- The Environmental Assessment acknowledges impacts to mainland moose and other wildlife, including disturbance and displacement over a broad area, raising serious concerns under Nova Scotia's Endangered Species Act and the Mainland Moose Recovery Plan.
- There remains no confirmed transmission route, demonstrating that a critical component of the project is unresolved, while also reflecting ongoing landowner resistance.
- The Assessment does not adequately address cumulative effects, particularly the long-term impacts of permanent access, habitat fragmentation, and increased human activity in a currently intact landscape.
- Claims of community support are not reflective of the full picture. A petition circulated within the local community has gathered over 400 signatures (which can be provided if required), and a local community Facebook group, Protect Eigg Mountain from Industrial Wind, has grown to over 500 members, where many residents are actively expressing concern and opposition to the project.

This project represents industrial-scale development within and throughout a sensitive and valued wilderness area. Once approved and constructed, the resulting impacts will be permanent and irreversible.

This is a decision that cannot be undone.

Renewable energy development is important — but it must be responsibly sited. This location is not appropriate.

For these reasons, I respectfully request that the project be declined.

I am not an expert in environmental assessments or policy, but I am someone who lives in this community and cares deeply about the land and the environment around us.

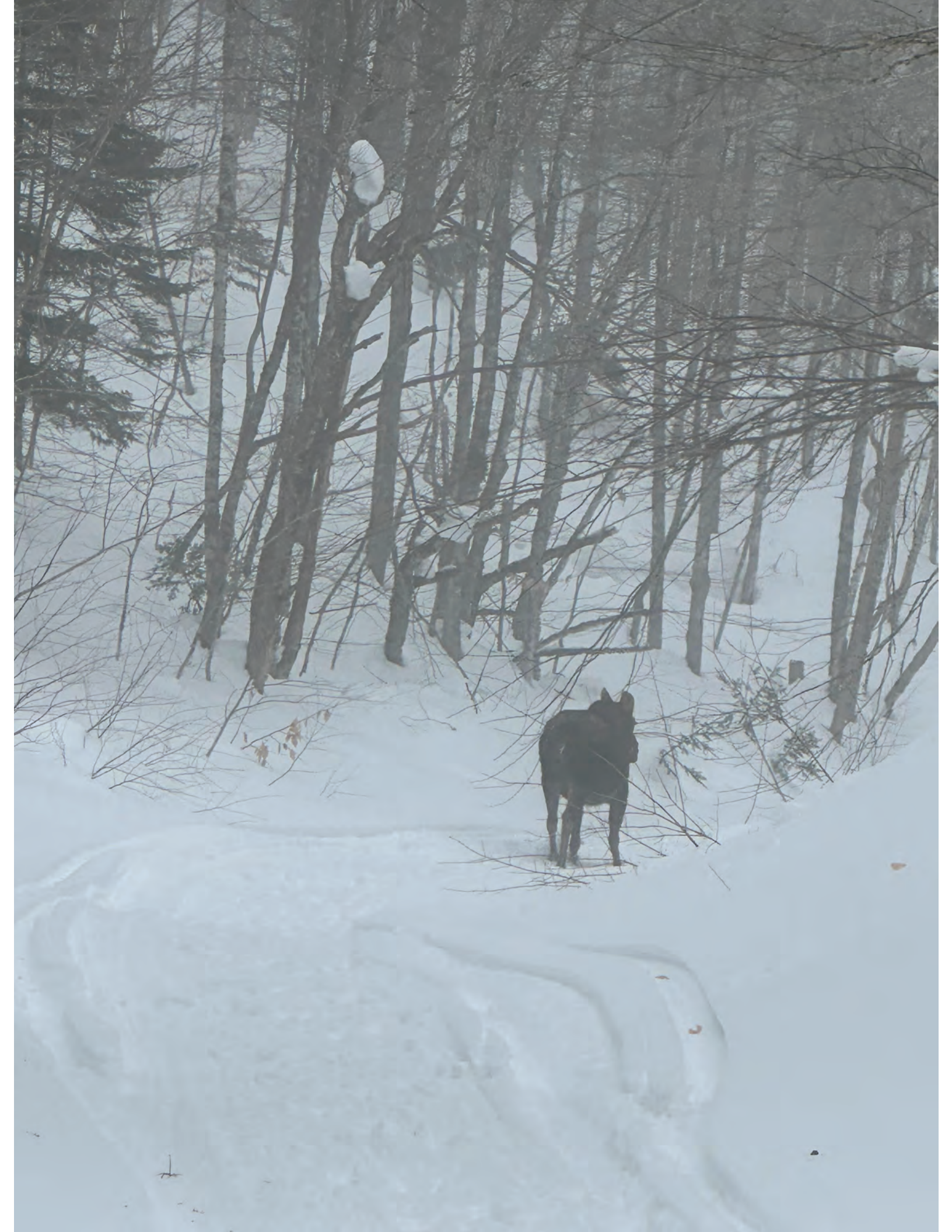

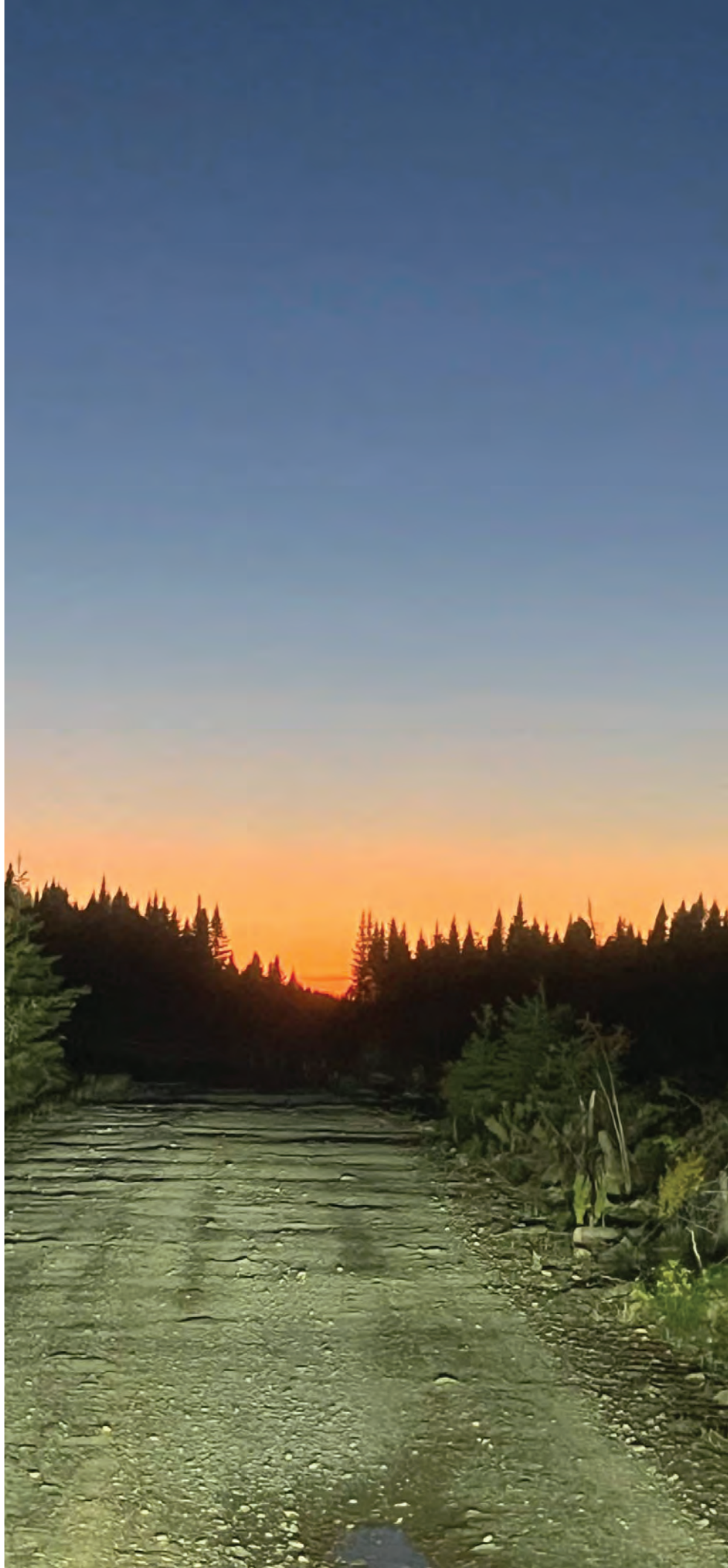
