## Registration of Undertaking for Environmental Assessment ENVIRONMENT ACT

This is to advise that on September 27, 2006, Springhill Riverhurst Wind Power Limited registered the Higgins 3.5 MW Wind Power project for environmental assessment, in accordance with Part IV of the *Environment Act*.

The purpose of the undertaking is to construct a wind power generating facility to generate electricity for transmission via the existing NSPI grid. The project consists of construction and operation of three, 1.2 megawatt (MW) wind turbines near Westchester Station, Cumberland County, Nova Scotia. The Proponent plans to begin construction in the fall of 2006 and operation to begin in late spring 2007.
