Registration of Undertaking for Environmental Assessment ENVIRONMENT ACT

This is to advise that on February 6, 2017, Nova Scotia Transportation and Infrastructure Renewal registered the Highway 101 Digby to Marshalltown Corridor Project for environmental assessment, in accordance with Part IV of the *Environment Act*.

The proposed Project is to construct a new Highway 101 for the section from Digby to Marshalltown. This involves the construction, operation, and maintenance of 4 km of a new 100-series four-lane highway from Exit 26 in Digby to Middle Cross Road in Marshalltown. The new highway will be constructed initially as a two-lane, controlled access corridor with a design speed of 110 km/hr and posted speed of 100 km/hr. Construction for the initial two lanes is planned to begin in 2017. Sufficient right of way will be purchased initially so that a four-lane highway can be constructed; however, the schedule for this construction has not been determined. The new highway corridor will replace an uncontrolled access section of Highway 101. It will enhance safe flow of traffic, effectively managing traffic to improve the flow of people and goods in the region.
