Registration of Class II Undertaking and Preparation of Terms of Reference For Environmental Assessment Pursuant to the Nova Scotia Environment Act

This is to advise that on November 26, 2001, the Nova Scotia Department of Transportation and Public Works, Purdy's Wharf, Tower II, 4th Floor, 1969 Upper Water Street, Halifax, registered the Highway 104 at Antigonish Project for environmental assessment, in accordance with Part IV of the Environment Act.

The purpose of the proposed Class II undertaking is to construct a four lane divided highway that is intended to divert traffic from the uncontrolled and heavily developed sections of the existing Highway 104 in the Antigonish area. The proposed 15 km highway is located near the Town of Antigonish and community of South River, extending from Addington Forks Road easterly to Taylor Road.
