Registration of Addendum for Environmental Assessment

ENVIRONMENT ACT

This is to advise that on June 4, 2013, Scotian WindFields Inc., Scotian Wind Inc., and WEB Wind Energy North America Inc. registered an addendum to the Martock Ridge Community Wind Project Registration Document originally submitted on January 13, 2013, in accordance with Part IV of the *Environment Act*.

The addendum is in response to the Minister of Environment's decision dated March 7, 2013, wherein it was advised that the information contained in the Registration Document was insufficient to allow for a decision and that additional information was required. The additional information required was related to proximity of the proposed Project to receptors, and demonstrating compliance with setback distances, noise levels and shadow flicker guidelines. In addition, detailed information was requested related to the steps take to address concerns regarding the protection of the Mill Lakes Watershed Protected Area.
