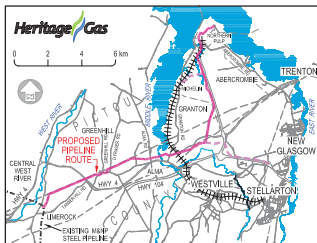

Natural Gas Pipeline Installation from Existing Pipeline in West River to Abercrombie Point

From September through to December 2013, Heritage Gas Limited proposes to construct a 19km high pressure steel natural gas pipeline from the existing Maritimes & Northeast Pipeline steel transmission line in West River. Phase I of this new pipeline will distribute natural gas to industrial customers at Abercrombie Point. Phase II of this project may be a possible extension to New Glasgow, Stellarton and Trenton in 2014 and beyond.

About 75% of this pipeline will be constructed along existing corridors or within previously disturbed land, i.e., existing road, rail or utility corridors, or agricultural land. The remaining alignment is within privately managed woodlots. The pipeline will cross under wetlands and watercourses using horizontal directional drilling, a trenchless technique that is typically used for crossing of obstacles without adversely impacting the environment. As per Heritage Gas' policy, environmental protection is a key aspect of this work. This project also includes construction and operation of a pressure reducing station at the connection to the steel transmission line in West River.
