We understand that Sovereign Resources is currently undertaking an environmental assessment for the proposed modification of their existing quarry on Rocky Lake Drive, Bedford. Our understanding is that Sovereign Resources wishes to modify the approved operational activities and permitted quarry area and therefore must register this project under the Environmental Assessment Act as a Class I Undertaking.

The Millbrook First Nation has an interest in matters related to land and resource in all of Nova Scotia and in particular in HRM. Reserve lands exist in Cole Harbour and we have a land claim process underway for parts of Shannon Park. Officials from Sovereign Resources have discussed their project with me and I am pleased to advise that the Millbrook First Nation has no plans to object to this project.
