## **NOTICE** Registration of Undertaking For Environmental Assessment ENVIRONMENT ACT

This is to advise that on January 30th, 2024, Irving Shipbuilding Inc. registered the Temporary Material Staging Facility for Environment Assessment in accordance with Part IV of the Environment Act.

The purpose of the proposed undertaking is to construct and operate a temporary facility to sort and process debris and marine dredge material sourced from the Irving Shipyard Land Level Expansion Project in the Halifax Harbour. The project includes the construction and operation of a containment cell and dewatering system which will receive on average 600m3 of dredged materials with the maximum volume on site not exceeding 20,000 m3 at any one time. The facility will be located at 79 and 119 Deepwater Drive in Woodside, Dartmouth, in Halifax County, NS. If approved the project would commence sorting activities in early 2024 and operate intermittently until December 2026.
