Registration of Undertaking for Environmental Assessment ENVIRONMENT ACT

This is to advise that on June 7, 2023, WEB Weavers Mountain Wind GP Inc. Glooscap Energy #2 Limited Partnership (as represented by its general partner Glooscap Energy #2 GP Ltd.), and SWEB Development Limited Partnership (as represented by its general partner SWEB Development Inc.), carrying on business as WEB Weavers Mountain Wind Limited Partnership registered the WEAVERS MOUNTAIN WIND ENERGY PROJECT for environmental assessment, in accordance with Part IV of the Environment Act.

The purpose of the proposed undertaking is to construct and operate an up to 16 turbine, up to 99.2 MW wind project. The wind turbines will be up to 206.5 m tall to the tip of the blade and individually produce up to 6.2 MW. The Project is located on the border of Antigonish County and Pictou County, west of the community of Beaver Meadow, NS and will also involve electrical collector lines and substation, access roads, and temporary laydown areas. The Project intends to begin construction in 2024 and is expected to be operational for 25 years commencing in 2025.
