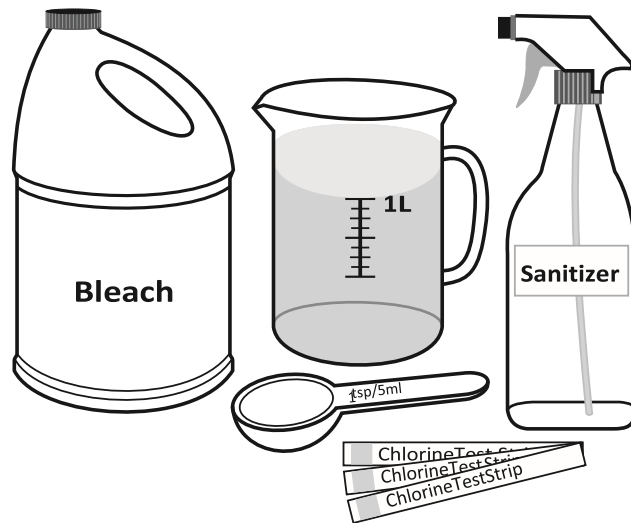


How to Mix a Chlorine Bleach Sanitizer

Temporary Event Guidelines/Public Markets

What you will need:

1. Ordinary household chlorine bleach (5.25%), without scent
2. Teaspoon
3. Spray bottle labelled "Sanitizer"
4. Water
5. Chlorine test strips



How to prepare:

1. Mix $\frac{1}{2}$ to one teaspoon (2–5 ml) bleach into one litre of water.
2. Test to ensure a sanitizing strength of 100 ppm.
3. Label the container "Sanitizer" so it is not mistaken as a food ingredient.

Tips to Remember:

1. Do not mix bleach with soap.
2. Use chlorine test strips to check the strength of the solution.
3. Discard sanitizing solution every 3 hours or as needed. The strength of the solution weakens over time.
