***SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS**

- Proof of ownership/Agreement/Legal Right to conduct activity.
- Site plans, PIDs, GPS coordinates with exact locations of spraying.
- **Detailed Description of Activity.**
- Details of Site Suitability and Sensitivity including if in/near a municipal watershed.
- Substance Description and Controls Product used, approved applicator, rate of application and methodology, description of adverse effect, contingency plan.
- Public Consultation Description plan for notification, written notice to owners within 500m of the treatment site, picture of signage.
