Within headwaters of Sackville River ↓ an Atlantic salmon river

Over 1 km of frontage on Sackville River

Some old tolerant hardwood and black spruce forest stands

Outdoor Recreation Values

Opportunities for nature appreciation and education associated with Lewis Lake Girl Guide camp

Primarily mature softwood with some mature hardwood and mixedwood

Some old access roads and roadbeds
