Mature and old sugar maple and yellow birch forests
Steep river canyons, reportedly with several waterfalls
Improves representation of Keppoch Mountain Natural Landscape

Forestry Values

Mostly hardwood with some softwood within several hundred meters of logging road, but may be difficult to access because of terrain

Medium with some small areas of high wind potential
