Overview

Large property on the Eastern Shore with frontage on several lakes and containing important conservation values and outdoor recreation opportunities. Proposed expansion of boundary will enhance the property's protection and recreation values

Protection Values

Includes old red spruce and tolerant hardwoods. Wetlands and extensive freshwater shoreline on several lakes. Lake islands. Connections to a large contiguous block of Crown land. Property was acquired as part of a commitment by the Province in the mid-1970s to establish the Eastern Shore Seaside Park System. Identified by Nova Scotia Department of Environment as part of lands (Patch # 205) that could contribute to the Province's goal of protecting 12% of the land base by 2015.

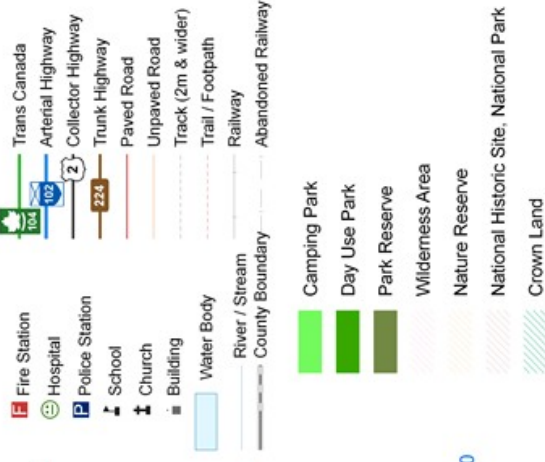
