Only provincial park in Inverness County located on Cabot Trail; access to freshwater lake; well used; serves primarily traveling public; popular with tour buses as a rest/viewing location

Picnicking, lake access, carry-in boating, boat ramp, fishing, fishing derby in recent years

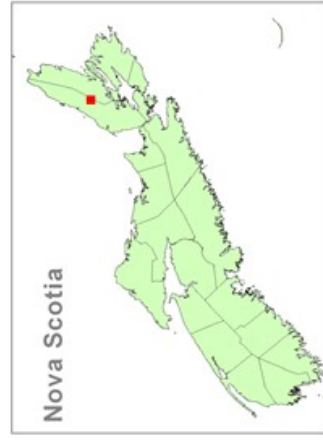
