Supervised swimming, bird watching, Family Fun night is a regular event offered through Clare Recreation Department and Festival Acadian; sand castle/sculpture event, surfing clinic

Sand dunes constantly changing; beach character changes/and erosion; sand covers board walks every winter creating unique maintenance issues.

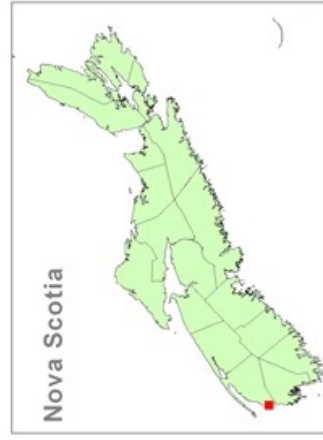
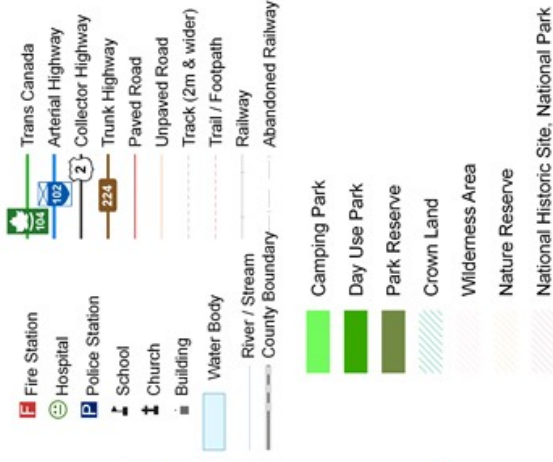
Susceptible to coastal processes (storm events with high tide surge or wind driven waves) that cause site erosion
