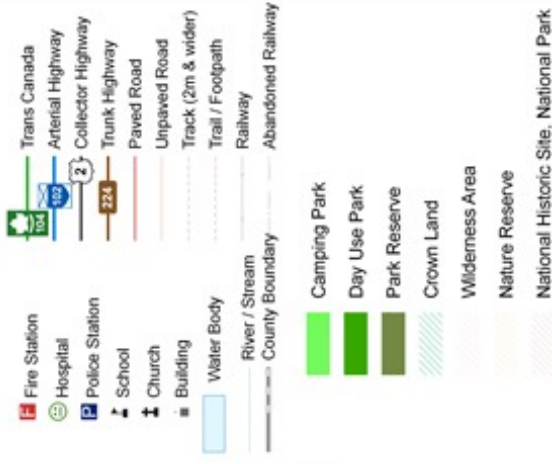
Well used, dunes are moving landward impacting park facilities
