Provides public access to Eastern Shore, beach activities, boating; serves primarily local area; growing in popularity.

Beach access, picnicking, walking.

Susceptible to coastal processes (storm events with high tide surge or wind driven waves) that cause site erosion.

Limited suitable landbase for development due to terrain and wetland
