Susceptible to coastal processes (storm events with high tide surge or wind driven waves) that cause site erosion.

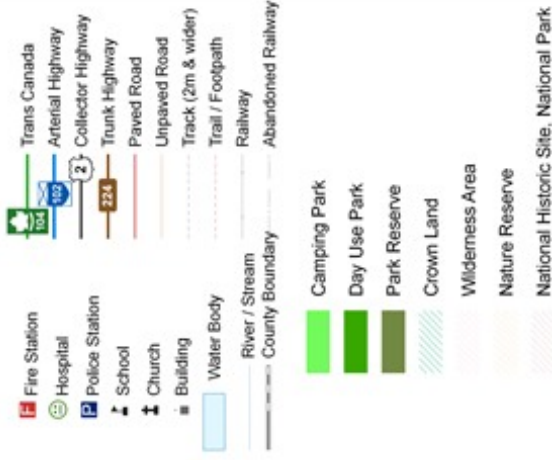
Maturing forest cover may require ecological restoration program to remove dead and dying trees in areas of public use to re-establish a more suitable forest cover.
