Other Site Considerations

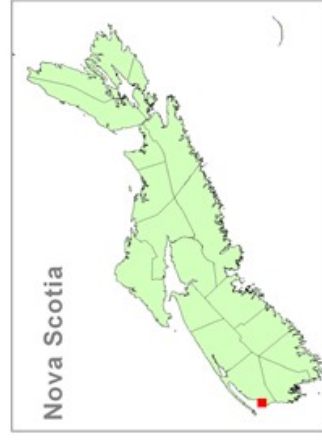
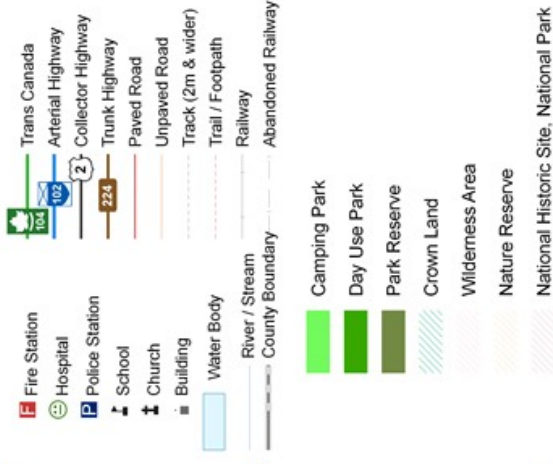
Mature softwood ecological restoration program to remove dead and dying trees in areas of public use may be required.
