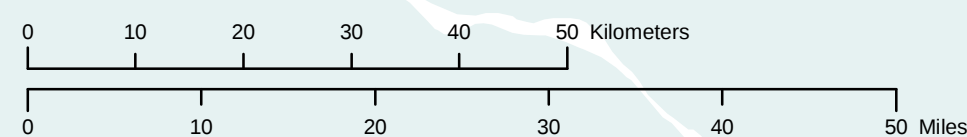

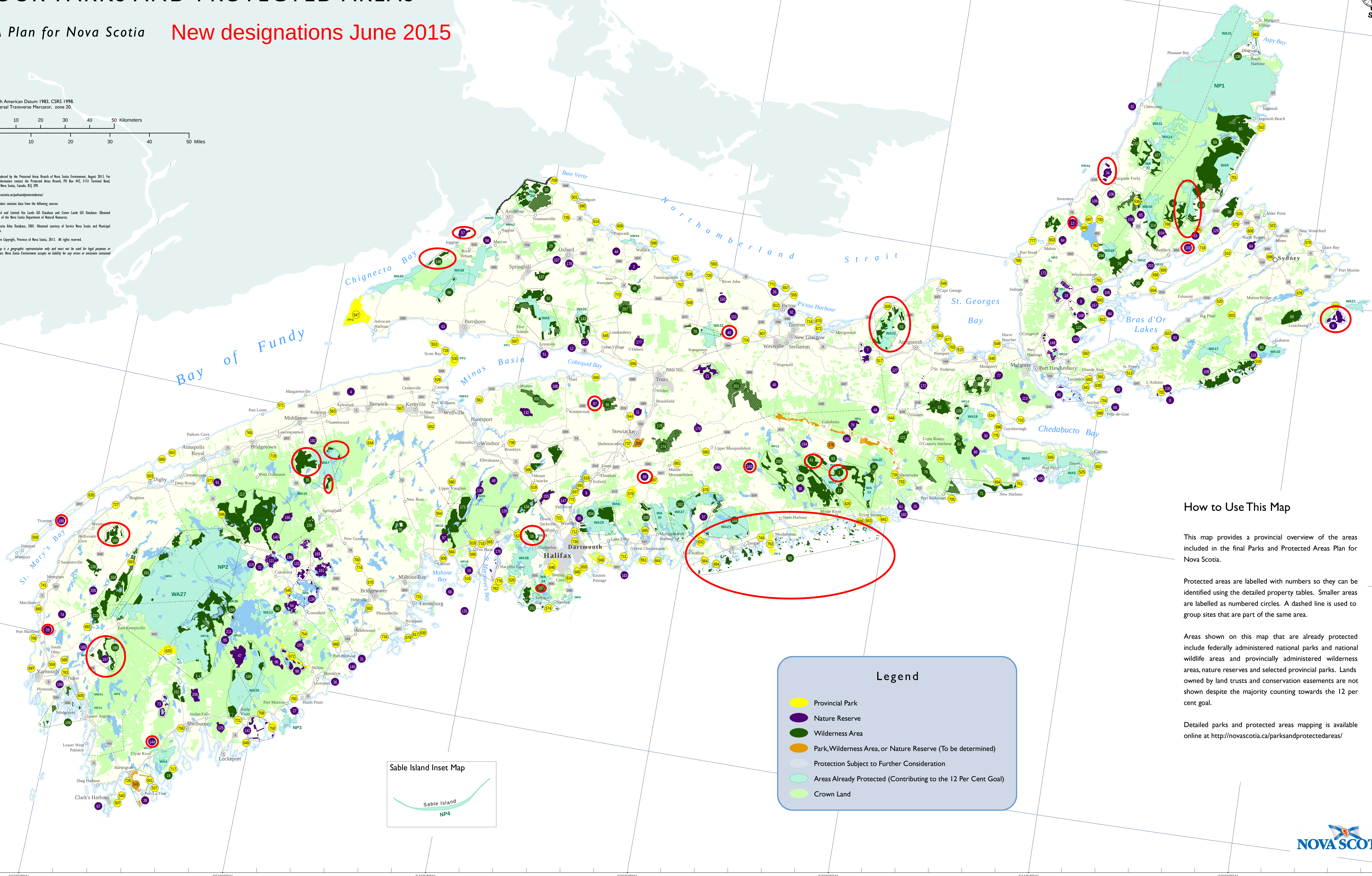
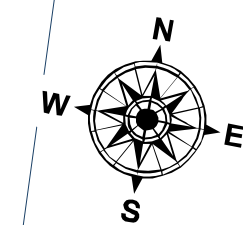

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How to Use This Map

This map provides a provincial overview of the areas included in the final Parks and Protected Areas Plan for Nova Scotia.

Protected areas are labelled with numbers so they can be identified using the detailed property tables. Smaller areas are labelled as numbered circles. A dashed line is used to group sites that are part of the same area.

Areas shown on this map that are already protected include federally administered national parks and national wildlife areas and provincially administered wilderness areas, nature reserves and selected provincial parks. Lands owned by land trusts and conservation easements are not shown despite the majority counting towards the 12 per cent goal.
