How to complete this section: Use this worksheet when an invoice does not show the total feed weight or bale size. Add each invoice from the Drought Period, August 1, 2025 – May 15, 2026, on its own line in the table below. For each invoice, write the invoice number, invoice date, amount of feed bought, feed type, and feed unit. Complete one row for each invoice. If one invoice includes more than one feed type or bale size, use a separate row for each one.

Use only the feed types and feed units listed on this page. If your feed type or feed unit is not listed, select the closest match. If you bought chopped silage, write the weight you bought in the amount column and leave the bale size column blank.

Programs will use this information to calculate the total weight of feed bought during the Drought Period.

Dry Hay	3x4x8 square bale	1000 lbs
	5 ft (55-60") round bale	660 lbs
Alfalfa	3x3x8 square bale	808 lbs
Wrapped silage	3x3x6 square bale	990 lbs
	4 ft (48-50") round bale	520 lbs
	4.5 ft (52-54") round bale	1350 lbs
