 - $\sqrt{}$ Generate an annual eligible gross income of \$30,000 or more. The eligible income will be based on the Farm Registration annual income.
 - √ Current (within five years) Environmental Farm Plan, including schedule A and B (projects applied for must be listed on these)
 - $\sqrt{}$ Is at least 19 years of age


