

**2017 Property Tax Rebate for Seniors**  
**Program Deadline: Post Marked by December 31, 2017**

Service Nova Scotia will once again deliver the Property Tax Rebate for Seniors Program on behalf of Community Services. The program provides a 50% rebate of the actual Residential Municipal property taxes you paid, up to a maximum of \$800.

**Application Information/Instructions:**

- All applications must be **Post Marked by December 31, 2017**, which is the Program Deadline. **All applications post marked after December 31<sup>st</sup> will automatically be declined.**
- Please complete the entire form. An incomplete application may result in the form being returned, thereby causing a delay in processing the claim. **Note: We do not accept Faxed or Copied Signatures**

**You must meet All of the following criteria to be eligible for the rebate:**

- You must provide proof that you received or were eligible to receive the Guaranteed Income Supplement or the Allowance in **JANUARY 2017**. If you do not have proof, please call Service Canada at 1-800-277-9914 to obtain a letter as proof.
- You must provide proof that your **2016 MUNICIPAL RESIDENTIAL PROPERTY TAXES** are in your name or include your name and that you **own and are living in your home** at the time of application.
- You must provide proof that your 2016 Municipal Residential Property Taxes are **paid in full** and **include** the bill(s) and receipt(s) with your application. **We need to verify your taxes are paid in full.** If you **do not** have a receipt(s) showing that your taxes are paid in full, please provide a Municipal Property Tax Sheet as proof. A Municipal Property Tax Sheet can be obtained by calling local 902-424-5200 or toll free 1-800-670-4357. **Please take this form to your Municipality where it can be filled out by an official representative of the Municipality. Due to high volume of applications, the Municipal Property Tax Sheet may take up to 4 to 6 weeks to process.**
